Black History Month Comedy Show Bill

WHEREAS, The celebration of Black History Month serves as an opportunity to be reminded of cultural achievements, stimulating meaningful conversations, and acknowledging Black history as American history; **AND,**

WHEREAS, The Florida Atlantic Chapter of The Black Student Union has started the tradition of an annual Black History Month Comedy Show in the Carole and Barry Kaye Auditorium to showcase cultural talents and diversity; **AND,**

WHEREAS, The Black History Month Comedy Show emphasizes Florida Atlantic University's diverse student population with an invaluable cultural experience; **AND,**

WHEREAS, Hosting the second Black History Month Comedy Show at Florida Atlantic University would continue to promote diversity, inclusion, and equity, while increasing the relationship of the student body and raising school spirits; **AND,**

WHEREAS, The Black History Month Comedy Show is free for students and is inclusive to all individuals ; **AND,**

WHEREAS, \$35,000 will cover the costs of the performer Druski and his all-inclusive fees; **AND,**

WHEREAS, \$3,500 will cover the costs of the management fees to Degy Entertainment; **AND,**

WHEREAS, \$600 Inclusive of assistance in booking an opening act, securing a host and DJ; **AND,**

WHEREAS, \$6,000 will cover the costs of the box office fees, security, security passes, and student union services; **AND,**



WHEREAS, \$3,450 will cover the costs of the decorations, food, promotional items, and comedian essentials; **AND**,

WHEREAS, \$3,450 will cover the unforeseen and last-minute costs; **AND**,

WHEREAS, The Executive Board members of the Black Student Union and Student Government members has successfully sought out other Student Government account holders for assistance with funding, but are still in need of financial assistance **NOW**,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, This will be a university-wide event extending to all branches and leaderships at Florida Atlantic University to be on board; **NOW**,

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Florida Atlantic University Student Government Senate allocates \$6,000 from Senate Contingency (TAG 001504) including overhead to finalize to finalize the total contribution for the comedy show to the Black Student Union to go towards the Second Annual Black History Month Comedy Show, in a joint effort with registered student organizations. If these funds are not utilized by April 1, 2023, then they will be reverted to the Senate Contingency Funds.
