*a. SGSSB-2026-24– Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life Signage Bill*

- b. *SGSSB-2026-25 – Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life Budget Realignment Bill*

  - ii. *Sen. Trewin debates in favor, stating the bill would better utilize existing FSL funding by reallocating funds from an unfilled graduate assistant position to FSL operating costs.*
  - iii. *Pro Temp. Rodriguez asks where the funds will come from. Sen. Trewin clarifies that the funds are already allocated to FSL and will be reallocated internally.*
  - iv. *Senate moved to a roll call vote.*
